Privacy Policy/Your Privacy Rights

This policy pertains to personal information collected through this website and on MyIDAccess | ID Report's behalf through related websites managed by third parties. Use and Disclosure of Your Information

We may use and/or disclose your PII for the following reasons:

- to contact you in response to your inquiries, comments and suggestions;
- to contact you otherwise when necessary;
- for the specific purpose for which it was volunteered;

- to improve the site and the services MyIDAccess | ID Report promotes or provides through the site;

How We Communicate with You

Automatic Data Collection through Cookies and Other Means
